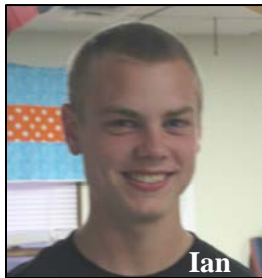
Kindergarten Going, Growing, and Grateful!
